

John Zouski, Village President called to order the Village Board Meeting on Tuesday, April 9, 2013 at 7:30 P.M. in the Municipal Building.

Roll Call: Dan Reid, Angela Wiese, Dorothy Caves, Wayne Cummings, Amanda Gear and Jeffrey Reabe.

Motion by Zouski, second by Wiese to approve the agenda as submitted.
Motion carried.

Motion by Caves, second by Wiese to approve the minutes from March 5, 2013.
Motion carried.

Guests: Dan Miller, Corey Conley, Dean Wiese, Alva Gear, Alesa Ludtke, Ed Makaryk, Doug Beggs and Keven Fenske.

Beggs came to the board to address the feral cat problem at his property. He said that he is not the only person in the neighborhood that has a problem with the cats. He said they are messing on his front porch and on or by his vehicle. He said he has had outdoor lawn furniture ruined and he is sick of the stench. He said even if he wanted to sell his property, it would be difficult with the problem with these cats. Zouski explained that we do not have an ordinance regarding feral cats and so it is very difficult to do anything about them. Gear said she will be contacting pest control and see if there is something that they can do to take of this problem and what the cost would be to the Village. Some other ideas were to live trap them and then take them to the humane society.

Reabe said that the Fire Dept. had some changes in personnel on the agenda for tonight for approval. He also said the Fire Dept. is requesting access to some funds from the Fire Commission Account (10/50) to equip an UTV that they are purchasing. The equipment that would be purchased for the UTV will be a 55-75 gallon water tank and hose. The Fire Dept. will be purchasing the UTV, a John Deere Gator, and a trailer to haul it, from their Firefighters, Inc. account. Reabe said that the squad car needs a new seat. He is asking Area Wide to get a price on what a replacement seat would cost.

Motion by Gear, second Reabe to approve Marie Reid placing and running a food trailer in Garden Square Park. Motion carried. Dan Reid abstained.

Motion by Reabe, second by Reid to approve withdrawing a \$6,600.00 out of the Fire Commission account to equip a UTV for the Fire Dept. Motion carried. Angela Wiese abstained.
