John Zouski, Village President called to order the April 8, 2014 Board Meeting at 7:30 p.m. in the Municipal Building.

Roll Call: Reid, Wiese, Caves and Gear present. Cummings and Reabe absent.

Motion by Wiese, second by Gear to approve the agenda as submitted. Motion carried.

Motion by Wiese, second by Caves to approve the minutes from March 4, 2014. Motion carried.

Motion by Reid, second by Zouski to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried.

Items For Discussion:

Some of the senior citizens have approached the board members regarding doing some upgrades in the Municipal Building. Some items they would like to see updated is new ceiling tiles, new carpeting and new tiles on the kitchen floor. Bender also said that he would like to see the large safe moved as he feels it is a hazard for people using the center. He was also concerned with the lighting and asked if it could be updated. Zouski said that he would hand this over to the building committee to meet with the seniors and discuss what could be done this year. There is money available in the senior citizens account to do some of these repairs and then this money would not have to come out of the budget.

The next item discussed was the cleanup of unsightly yards in the Village. Zouski said he had been asked by some Village residents what could be done to clean up some of these yards. We do have ordinances in place regarding unlicensed vehicles and other debris in yards and the police dept. could start issuing citations if not cleaned up. He will speak to Chief Kumferman regarding this.

Motion by Reid, second by Wiese to approve Wayne Cummings as second signature on Village Checks with the Plainfield Community Bank. Motion carried.
