

John Zouski, Village President called to order the July 2, 2013 Village Board Meeting at 7:30 P.M. in the Municipal Building.

Roll Call: Dan Reid, Dorothy Caves, Wayne Cummings, Amanda Gear and Jeffrey Reabe. Angela Wiese was absent.

Motion by Reid, second by Gear to approve the agenda with the additions of Andrew Kleutgen and Nicole Kleutgen for approval of operator's licenses for Plfd. Bowl and Bar and approval of Eric Blume and Travis Czapinski as new Fire Dept. members. Motion carried.

Motion by Cummings, second by Caves to approve the minutes from the June 4, 2013 meeting. Motion carried.

Guests: Dan Miller, Dave Barker, Alva Gear, Dean Wiese and Ed Makaryk.

Miller came to present the titles for the new UTV John Deere 825i Gator with tracks and an aluminum trailer to the Village Board. Zouski thanked the Fire Department for their donation of this UTV. All funds for the purchase of the Gator were raised by the Plainfield Firefighters Incorporated.

Barker came to ask the status of a letter that was sent to his neighbor regarding the placemen of storage sheds. Zouski explained that a certified letter had been sent to the homeowner, but he had not signed for it yet. After three attempt are made to contact the homeowner the board will see what steps are to be taken next. Barker is concerned because the neighbor has placed two storage sheds over onto his property line and he would like them moved.

Wiese reported on a fire that they had on Monday. He said that his men did an outstanding job. He said the State Fire Marshal had been called in and that an investigation was taking place. He explained that the fire was contained with minimal water usage and a life was saved. Hancock and Wild Rose Fire Departments also assisted with the fire and all departments were commended by the Village Board for the professional way that it was handled.

Motion by Reid, second by Zouski to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried.

Committee Reports:

Caves said she would like to see the Waterman Park bathroom work done by July 15th. Some items that need to be done are the wall partitions outside taken down, painting of the interior and epoxy put on the floor. The new door locks have been installed.

Gear said that pump #1 and #2 repairs were completed.

Reabe also commended the Fire Dept. on a very good job done at the fire on Monday.

Items For Discussion:

The two new fire department members on for approval were o.k.'d by Chief Kumferman and could be approved tonight.

Waushara County has done a Pawnbroker Ordinance and is going to be enforcing and permitting it county wide. Zouski explained that the Village does not need to have an ordinance in place at this time. Attorney Bickford advises us to just let the county do the enforcing and permitting at this time and if there is a problem later on that we could enact our own Village Ordinance regarding pawnbrokers.
