From the Police Dept.....

WINTER PARKING

No operator of any vehicle shall park any vehicle on any public street in the Village of Plainfield between 2:00 AM and 6:00 AM from November 1st to April 15th of each year. The no parking times for vehicles parked on STH 73 will be 2:45 AM to 6:00AM. Any vehicles found in violation can be cited and removed at the owner's expense.

SIDEWALK SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL

The owner or person in charge of each building, structure, or unoccupied lot in the Village of Plainfield fronting or abutting any street shall clean or cause to be cleaned the sidewalk in front of or adjoining each such home, building, or unoccupied lot as the case may be of snow or ice to the width of such sidewalk within 24 hours after each snowfall, and shall cause the same to be kept clear from ice and snow. Any sidewalks found in violation of this ordinance will be cleaned by the village and the cost will be added to the property owner taxes.
