From the Police Dept –

The Village of Plainfield has just passed ordinance 8-5-1 allowing the operation of electric golf carts on certain village roads. You must have a permit issued by the Plainfield Police Department to legally operate a golf carts on village roads. You can contact the Plainfield Police Department at (715) 335-8282 to setup a time for your golf cart inspection. All golf carts must comply with the below listed rules in order to receive a permit.

1. The golf cart is equipped with a rear vision mirror and at least two red rear reflectors at least three inches in height and width;
2. The golf cart is equipped with a reflective 'slow moving sign' or 'flag' on the rear of the cart;
3. The brakes provided by the manufacturer of the golf cart are in proper working order;
4. The golf cart has all of the standard safety features provided by the manufacturer and has not been modified to exceed a speed of 20 miles per hour nor otherwise modified in any way that creates a hazard;
5. The golf cart is equipped with all mechanical systems and safety equipment required by this chapter;
6. A minimum of one headlight and taillight installed so as to not conflict with the vision of oncoming traffic; and
7. The golf cart does not and may not have any audio equipment.

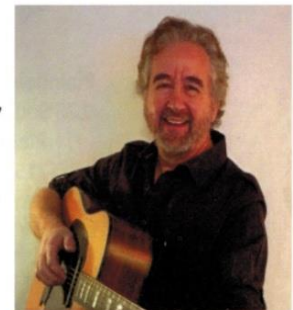
