

**Sec. 8-1-6 WINTER PARKING**

- (a) SEASONAL PARKING. No operator of any vehicle shall park any vehicle on any public street in the Village of Plainfield between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from and including November 1<sup>st</sup> to April 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.
- (b) PENTALTY. Any person who shall violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit not les then Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars nor more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars together with the cost of prosecution and in default of payment of the forfeiture and cost of prosecution shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until said forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding ninety (90) days.
- (c) REMOVAL OF ILLEGALLY PARKED VEHICLES. Any vehicles parked or left standing upon a highway or street of the Village of Plainfield in violation of the provisions of this Section is declared to be a hazard to traffic and public safety. Such vehicle shall be removed by the operator, upon request of any police officer to position where parking, stopping or standing is not prohibited. Any police officer after issuing a citation for illegal parking, stopping or standing of an unattended vehicle in violation of the Section is authorized to remove such vehicle to a position where parking is not prohibited. The officer may order a motor carrier holding a permit to perform vehicle towing services, a licensed motor vehicle salvage dealer or licensed motor vehicle dealer who performs vehicle towing services to remove and store such vehicle in any storage garage or rental parking grounds or any facility of the person providing the towing service. In addition to other penalties provided by this code the owner or operator of a vehicle so removed shall pay the cost of towing and storage.
